

# Remington

This map is a print of a digitized version of a handmade map by Remington residents and Greenmount School students, one of two collaborative maps completed during a fall 2007 workshop.

For this project, residents took walks around the neighborhood while recording places they liked to go. As with many other maps on display, this map works to locate community assets, but it also shows paths that correspond to different reasons for going certain places. Locations circled in red indicate assets that have the potential to be of much greater use to the community, such as the through the construction of gardens or skate parks.

This map allows the community of Remington to identify certain priorities for improvement, and asserts the need to utilize its own resources.
